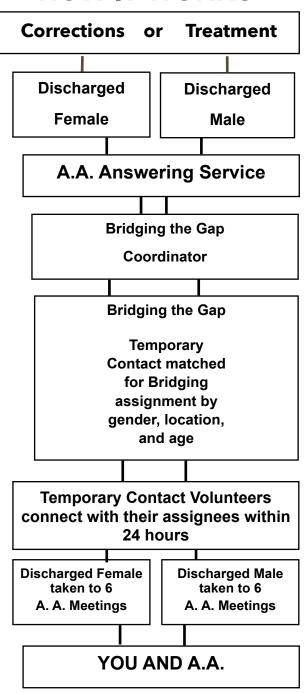

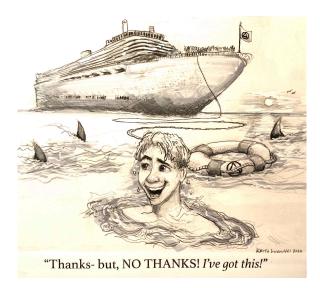

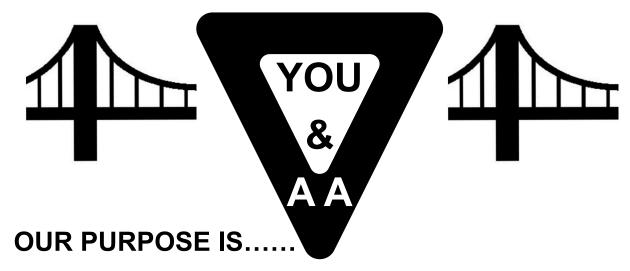


OUR COMMITMENT TO YOU
